THE HEART OF FAITH (vv. 1-6)

1. The Outward _____
 - a. V. 1, Whom, whom, fear, afraid = V. 2, Wicked, mine enemies, my foes, eat my flesh = V. 3, Host encamp, WAR! = V. 5, Time of trouble = V. 6, Mine enemies
 - b. There will ALWAYS be outward conflict until Jesus comes back for us!
 - c. Many times when there is outward conflict, there is inward conflict.

1. Live in the _____
 - a. V. 1 = "The LORD" is the first two words! = "The LORD" mentioned 10 times
 - b. I John 1:5, "This then is the message which we have heard of Him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all."
 - c. **John 1:4-9**
 - d. John 8:12, "Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I Am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."

- e. Psalm 119:105, "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."
 - f. Proverbs 6:23, "For the commandment is a lamp, and the law is light, and reproofs of instruction are the way of life."
