- a. _____ you pray is important!
- b. Notice some of the prayer requests:
 - i. V. 25 = I feel like I'm _____; give me life!
 1. These verses show that the Psalmist was going through a dark time.
 2. *Quicken* = "To revive; to give life to"
 3. "More life is the cure for all our ailments." – Spurgeon
 - ii. Vs. 26-27 = I feel like I'm in _____; give me light!
 - iii. V. 28 = I feel like I'm _____; lift me up!
 1. *Melteth* = "To be weary; sleepless"
 2. *Strengthen* = "To encourage; cheer up or console one who is weak or discouraged"
 3. Ask God to encourage your heart with His Word, THEN READ HIS WORD.
 - iv. Vs. 36-37 = I feel like I'm _____; lead me back!

2. The Importance of your _____. (vs. 33-40)

- a. These verses use 8 different words for the Bible. These 8 verses are all prayer requests.
- b. Vs. 33-35, 37 = The way or the path = Vs. 26, 27, 29, 30, 32 = The way
- c. Not only are your prayers important, but also the _____ you are headed is important.
- d. How are we supposed to know which path to walk? How do we know our direction? Again, the answer is and is found in the Word of God.
- e. Someone said, "For every mile you drive, there are two miles of ditch."
- f. How do you keep from the ditches? You stay on the _____ of the Word of God.
- g. Proverbs 4:26, "Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established."
- h. Maybe we ought to spend some time thinking about the direction we are headed!

- b. Vs. 42, 44 = "So shall I" = Vs. 45-48 = "I will"

 - i. V. 44 = I will _____ God's Word forever. What a determination!
 - ii. V. 46 = I will talk about God's Word _____. Have you decided this?
 - iii. V. 47 = I will _____ God's Word. Is it a routine to you or is it a well of water? Is it a duty or is it a delight?
 - iv. V. 48 = I will think on God's Word. I will think Biblically. _____!
