Revelation 20:11-15

- There are many other books mentioned in the Bible that are not included in the Biblical canon.
 - Numbers 21:14 = The Book of the Wars of the Lord
 - Joshua 10:13; II Samuel 1:18 = The Book of Jasher
 - I Chronicles 29:19 = The Book of Samuel the Seer, the Book of Nathan the Prophet, and the Book of Gad the Seer are all mentioned
 - II Chronicles 9:29 = The Book of Nathan the Prophet, the Prophecy of Ahijah the Shilonite, and the visions of Iddo the Seer
 - II Chronicles 12:15 = The Book of Shemaiah the prophet and The Book of Iddo the Seer
- There were many other books mentioned regarding record keeping, chronology, and genealogies.

WHAT BOOKS ARE MENTIONED IN THE BIBLE?

1. The Book of the _____.
 - a. Joshua 1:8; 8:31, 34; 23:6; 24:26
 - b. This is referring to the Books of Moses – Genesis through Deuteronomy.
2. The Lamb's Book of _____.
 - a. Philippians 4:3, "...and with other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life."
 - b. Revelation 3:5; 13:8; 17:8; 20:12; 21:27
 - c. **What is in the Lamb's Book of Life?**
 - i. The name of those washed in the blood of the Lamb!
 - ii. The Book of Life contains the names of those who have been saved and have eternal life.
 - d. **Can you have your name _____ out from the Lamb's Book of Life?**
 - i. Rev 3:5, "He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels."
 - ii. This simply means that if your name is written in the book of life, it will never be blotted out. It is saying that those names will never be removed for eternity.
 - e. **If your name cannot be blotted out, then what did Moses mean in Exodus 32:32-33 and what did David mean in Psalm 69:28?**
3. The Book of the _____.
 - a. Exodus 32:32-33, "Yet now, if Thou wilt forgive their sin--; and if not, blot me, I pray Thee, out of Thy book which Thou hast written. And the LORD said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against Me, him will I blot out of My book."
 - b. Psalm 69:28, "Let them be blotted out of the book of the living..."
 - c. The book that Moses and David are talking about is simply the book of those that are living. David was praying for his enemies to die. Moses was saying that he would rather die than see his people destroyed or see God's glory suffer.
