“WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN HELL AND HADES IN THE BIBLE?”

Word	Language	Meaning	Biblical Explanation
Sheol	Hebrew (OT)	The grave / realm of the dead	The general place of the departed. Both righteous and wicked went there before Christ. Often translated “grave” or “hell” in KJV.
Hades	Greek (NT)	Unseen world of the dead	Greek equivalent of Sheol. Temporary holding place until final judgment. Contains conscious awareness.
Gehenna	Greek (NT)	Place of final punishment	Jesus’ main word for eternal hell. Named after the Valley of Hinnom, a place of burning refuse.
Tartarus	Greek (NT)	Deep prison	A special place of confinement for fallen angels, not humans.
Abyss	Greek	Bottomless pit	Prison for demonic spirits, not the final hell.
Lake of Fire	Greek phrase	Final judgment	The eternal destination of Satan, demons, death, hell, and all unbelievers.
Hell	English	Translation word	Not an original Bible word; used to translate several different terms.
